Seekers Youth Group is for children in Reception to Year 6.

What do we do at Seekers?

We meet during term time on Fridays from 6.30pm until 7.45pm and we play games, do crafts, quizzes, sing, have a Bible lesson and take home a work sheet. We also have a drink and biscuit to have a little break from other activities.

Who runs the group?

Seekers leaders are part of Warboys Baptist Church and have all been checked for suitability to work with young people. There are no paid staff. To find out more about our church please contact our minister Nigel Graham (01487 823405) or speak to a Seekers leader.

Our numbers may be limited by the premises size and number of leaders and as Seekers is generally very popular we have the right to limit numbers at any time.

What are the rules?

- · Be kind to each other
- Use polite words to everyone all the time (Do not swear or use bad language)
- Be careful with the games, equipment and premises.
- Respect and listen quietly to the leaders and carefully do what they ask you.

What about discipline?

We ask all parents/carers to support us in our expectations of reasonable standards of behaviour and conduct from all children at Seekers.

If your child has a problem of any kind please let us know and we will inform you if a problem arises here. Your child will have many opportunities to be rewarded for good behaviour/attitude and gain points for prizes.

We operate at the leaders' discretion but in general we follow this pattern: If behaviour warrants intervention a young person will receive a warning.

Two warnings in one evening results in them being banned from attending the next week.

Repeated bans will most likely result in a permanent ban until the end of that school year.
